Nustadia hosts Neighbourhood Meeting for Amherstburg Recreation Complex

WHAT: Nustadia Recreation Inc., the project managers for the Town of Amherstburg's new recreation complex, invites all stakeholders, user groups and Amherstburg residents to attend a Neighbourhood Meeting for the Amherstburg Recreation Complex.

The new 133,595 square foot recreation complex will house a twin pad arena, a premier baseball diamond, a Miracle League baseball diamond, an indoor synthetic playing field, and an outdoor synthetic football/soccer field. The fully accessible twin-pad arena and the Miracle League baseball diamond are the first of its kind in Canada.

The complex will meet the recreational needs of the entire community, provide opportunities for sport tourism, and will be energy efficient to operate. The Town of Amherstburg received financial assistance for the building of the recreation complex from the governments of Canada and Ontario under the BCF-CC.
